



First Look: 2025 Crime Data

These estimates are based on data submitted by more than 17,000 agencies, covering 96% of the population, for 2025. This increased from 16,675 agencies in 2024. More than 15,000 agencies submitted data via the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) for 2025. These agencies cover nearly 90% of the population. Nearly 500 more agencies reported via NIBRS in 2025 compared to 2024. The following data are considered preliminary and are subject to change prior to the release of "Reported Crimes in the Nation, 2025," which will be published on the FBI's Crime Data Explorer website later this year. * When elements beyond law enforcement's control prevent an agency from arresting and formally charging the offender, the agency can clear the offense exceptionally when established criteria are met. Examples include death of offender, victim's refusal to cooperate, or denial of extradition.
